Extract from Rules

Pairs entrants must be from the same Club and be registered playing members of a Club in membership of the Association. A player becomes registered as and when he/she plays in their first League match. Exceptions which will be considered on the same Club rule are husband and wife, siblings, long term partner who are registered playing members but with different Clubs.

Entrants must declare all Clubs that they are members of and indicate whether they are a playing member (in any League run by a bona fide Association) or just a social member, not playing on the green. Any entrant not declaring the above and subsequently being drawn on a green where they are a playing member will be disqualified unless good reason can be given for the oversight.

No practicing is allowed on any green chosen as a venue for the preliminary stages and final of the competition. Any player found to have contravened this rule will be disqualified. A player called upon to play in a match fixed by the Association or any other recognised Bowling Association, shall not be considered to be practicing. In the Pairs one player can be substituted up to play commencing in the Preliminaries but should the sub and his/her partner win, they must continue throughout the competition. The original named person cannot come back in.

Competitors having a bye and due to play an opponent who has already played on the day shall be allowed up to 10 minutes practice with one set of bowls.

Additional Rules for the Pairs

In the Pairs competition, entrants must be members of the same Club. One must also be a registered playing member of that Club and the other with dual membership, can be a registered playing member of another Club. The important factor is that the entry comes from a Club where they are both bona fide members and they are registered playing members within the Association.
